

Enterlan Grammar & Vocabulary

Enterlan is analytical, but there is a solid word order: SVO.

The past is indicated by the word "cu" in front.

The continuous is indicated by the word "si" in back.

Only definite articles are mentioned.

Mi cit fute.	I eat food.
Mi cit ta fute.	I eat the food.
Cu mi cit ta fute.	I ate the food.
Mi si cit ta fute.	I am eating the food.

Necessity is determined by if the sentence does not lose its intended meaning when a word is dropped. For example, when a past action is already described in a previous sentence as having happened in the past, the following sentence with that action will not use "cu".

The syllable structure is (C)CV(C), with the two extra consonants never used in conjunction and avoided as much as possible. Phonotactics are the same as in English, although adjusted for above. Words are derived from English, except for proper nouns. Stress is always on the first syllable.
