The syllable structure is (C)(C)V(N), but final syllables in roots must always end in a nasal.

These are the only allowed consonant clusters:

pl	kv	fl	sp
	kl		st
		sk

If the stressed syllable changes, then the vowel in the target syllable changes:

Front-init.: **Back-init.:** *Init. means the vowel in the initial stressed syllable.*

a -> ái	a -> áu
e -> éi	e -> á
i -> éi	i -> ái
o -> á	o -> á
u -> áu	u -> áu
